

Tammy Tip #6

Repairing Metal Wire Stands

When shopping at doll shows I have found many waist grippers and round plastic Tammy stands. The metal wire has always been missing. The problem is easy to solve you will need the following correct size wire clothes hanger, wire cutters, ruler, magic marker and crazy glue.



To check for the correct size hanger you will need an assortment of hangers. Place the the end of the wire hanger into the hole of the stand. **DO NOT FORCE** the end of the hanger if it is to tight it will crack the plastic.



You will be cutting a piece that is $7\frac{3}{4}$ " long. A magic marker works great marking on the hanger. Cut both sides with you wire cutters.



If your hanger is a little smaller than the hole you can put a few drops of crazy glue to hold the metal. After gluing the wire you will lean it up against something that is straight.



Completed Stand

This is a very easy project that anyone can do. Have fun....
