Organization and Storage of Tammy Family Clothing

Collecting Tammy and family clothing sometimes can be very overwhelming at times. Here are some of my organizational tips.

I was lucky enough to have the Collectors Guide to Tammy by Cindy Sabulis (who, by the way is a great friend and great author) to start with. I numbered all of Tammy's outfits 1 to 48; Pak clothes A – P, etc. Pepper P1-P25, Mom M1 – M 7, Dad and Ted D1 – D14, or you can use your own system. What ever works for your collection.

I purchased a comic book box, comic book sleeves and comic book backboards. You can check your yellow pages under comic books or ebay. The box pictured is 14" X 12" X 8". There are different sizes of boxes to choose from. I numbered each sleeve with my system. If you do not have the book you could write the name of the outfit on each sleeve for the family members outfits. I put the sleeves in the box order by the family member number that I have assigned to each outfit.

When I come home from the doll shows I put my new treasure away in the correct sleeve. NOT!!! Well sometimes. I also use post it notes on each sleeve to keep track of what ever else I need to complete the outfit. Hope this helps and happy collecting.
